## NOTANDA:

- 1. In regard to grace of the just in OT followed Philips, ETL, 23 (1947), 521-556; 24 (1948), 23-58 --to wit, that it was "inferior" to that of NT, of a different category, preparatory, differing not only degree of extension --as most authors hold-- but intensively as well --which interpretation seems best to square with revealed data, and which does not deny, however, that the Holy Ghost was "given" to the just of the OT.
- 2. Gave your doctrine "De potentia dicta morali".
- 3. Likewise your discussion on concursus generalis, actus secundi principales intellectus et voluntatis, posse operari, posse operari bonum supernaturale posse perseverare proxime vel remote, virtus infusus, gratia actualis as actus secundus a Deo productus, auxilia ordinaria et specialia.
