TO: those interested, with a request for help in filling it out

One of the chief factors in starting the Lonergan Centre at Regis College was the large amount of material extant in some form or other for the study of Lonergan's thought but not published in the usual sense of the word, and the need of a centre where this material could be made available to researchers.

Under that general heading a main area is that of tape--recordings of his occasional lectures, interviews, panel discussions, institutes, etc. In fact, when I drew up the first bibliography of his writings in 1964; I already noted the lack of any list of tape-recordings.

I am ready now to try so remedy that situation and my first step has been to draw up as complete a list as possible of the lectures, etc., themselves, so as to have an adequate base from which to operate in the search for recordings.

At the same time it somed to me it would be useful to extend the search beyond recordings to include reportationes of auditor; journal accounts, news reports, and the like. And this has become even more important with the entry into the scene of a significant new factor; the Centre has recently acquired from Father Lonergan a large quantity of very precious notes and papers accumulated over the last 40 years - a gold-mine for restarchers. Some of these papers are obviously sketches of lecture; to be delivered, but generally they show no date, nor do the give any external indication of the occasion for the lecture or of the circumstances of its delivery. Any account we can discover of the lectures, even if it be a simple news report, could therefore be helpful in the work of organizing these papers and raking their contents easily available.

Consequently, I have drawn up the following list with an eye to a wider range in our learch. Let me emplain the 5 columns: 1. Each item is numbered; it will be convenient in correspondence to be able to refer to a number, even though the list is tentative. 2. The date, title, and some imes circumstances of the lecture are caven in the 2nd column, with the listing in chronological order; quotation marks mean that the exact title of the lecture was indicated in my source, . The 3rd column gives the place of the licture; it could be useful if we have to turn to news reports. (Regi) College and Thomas II e Institute, which occur frequently in this and other columns, are abbreviated: RC and THI.) 4. The abbr: viations in the 4th column have the following meaning: All author's (i. e., Lonergan's) notes for a lecture, ATS - author's typescript (= the lecture verbatim). J - journal account (scil., scientific journal). MR - paws report, P - publication (note that ever when the lecture was jublished, tapes could be useful for following discussion), $R - \frac{reportatio}{r}$ by auditor, T - tape, TST - typescript of tape, <math>VT - v decotape, TST - typescript of tape. where tapes are to be fourly news reports are given, etc.

In general the criterion (not rigid) for inclusion is the extra-curricular character of the lecture. There is some overlapping with the bibliographies, 'ranslations are not taken into account the three are translations of some lectures.
