Table of contents of Gratia operans articles. Two pages in BL's handwriting, of Table of Contents of Gratia operans articles in TS. The page numbers give some hint of when the outline was written. The table of contents of the first two articles (containing parts I, II, and III of the material) give the published page numbers. The remainder gives page numbers presumably of BL's own typescript, and the headings of the third article (containing part IV of the material) differ from those of the published articles. Thus the table of contents seems to have been put together after the publication of the second article. Further evidence of this is that bibliographical information is given for the first two articles, whereas the remainder is headed twice simply by TS.

Because of the discrepancies between the table of contents and the published material, item A42 is here reproduced in full.
