II Method is concerned to theology at the moment of development  
moment of increasing consciousness  
" " reason  
" " wisdom

What is known of any moment is true of all  
hence method of theology | revealed in its history  
| to be applied in its future

III Sum of developments = Theology as a whole at any given time  
hence indirectly concerned to theological doctrine  
i.e. Method must be such as to engage series of developments  
that integrate  
But method itself is concerned to moment

IV Change is concrete : abstractions do not change  
personal, essentially : it is an imitation of a  
responsible individual  
historical : it is from previous sum of developments  
to a fuller sum (see "one")  
social : goes forward in Church,
