

## The Problem of a Critical Social History

- $\alpha$  the problem is solved by the conjunction of a 

dynamic systems
technical history
- i.e. there is the form of solution for an general problem of critical history
- without the dynamic of systems there is lacking the upper grade  
 " " technical history there is lacking the lower grade

$\beta$  thereby the appropriate dynamic systems presupposes  
 the achievement of the dynamic systems on the relevant level

- i.e. ① the unification of epistemology, ontology, methodology, metaphysics
- ② the formulation of their imposed or latent forms  
 ③ the scheme of their development (interactions & series)  
 ④ the account of causal - positions & their significance  
 in the process of development (2)

$\gamma$  the appropriate dynamic of systems presupposes the

- ① development of a theory as the foundational  
theory of epistemological acts i.e. history of system
- ② the formulation of its imposed or latent forms  
 ③ the scheme of its development  
 ④ account of causal - positions

$\delta$  the appropriate dynamic of systems presupposes  
 the unification of  $\beta$  &  $\gamma$  - history as a logic of groups  
 theory including  $\beta$  - as opposed to their separation by specialists  
 & causal - positions
