Function of

Method - an opinion, well chosen & intelligent, not arbitrary, not dogmatic
≡ not arbitrary, an opinion

1. Notion proposed by a long history - not easy to grasp - outline significant steps in its development - merely outline but may be helpful - approx to ideal cannot exclude all interpretation of what I say

2. Heidegger $\left\{ \begin{array}{l} \text{intelligible - reasonable or practical truths} \\ \text{everything penetrated by myth & magic} \end{array} \right.$
up to H. C. H. then concentrated at 1970 Jaspers - Heidegger

3. Bruno Bauer, The Discovery of Mind

Socrates Plat M 4 1078 b 27 ff 4 12 | universal definitions
λόγος ἐπιπέριτος

Athenians knew what they meant by courage & cowardice, holocaust and indignance, justice & injustice, knowledge & ignorance but they could not give universal definitions

primary / thematic | meaning thematic via universal definition

"Theoria" that could bear strain of abstract discourse

4. Aristotle - extension of content of meaning by thematizing linguistic meaning to universal

language | literal & figurative: simile metaphor synecdoche metonymy personification allometry hyperbole litotes → rhetorical poetic devices
reveals a rationalization of language: primary communication / look | UE / LL

Organon

- what literal language refers to: categories good question goals - - -
- what literal language means: interpretation
- how literal language expresses valid inference: Prima Anal
- how to reach inference leads to construction of a reality: ideal: Post Anal
- approximations to sc. knowledge: Topics
- how unsorted inferences arise: Sophistical Refutation

Uses of Organon

- world of nature: physics, De Caelo, de generatione corr., de animalibus, de animalibus
- world of man: ethics politics economics
- totalities: metaphysics

5. The Installation of Ar in Medieval Culture

via theology dans le régime de la scolastique / Canguier
" " intelligible / Albert le Grand

via ars scientia, ars, ars dentium
+ metaphysics articulation for Latin culture / there is transmission of vs from Canguier

aptitude theology concerned in medieval regime - order of / Canguier
Ar, medieval: analogously a science / logical manner
clear opposition between / successive transition unconscious / criticism of creation / reception / selection

6. The Significance of ^{Geo} Method

it is a control of meaning { not by appeal to linguistic operations
{ but by appeal to cognitive operations

logic: defining, affirming, denying, inferring

^{Geo} they are cognitive operations, but selected by immediacy of linguistic express

method: unceasing logical operations
 adds others: deduction, description, hypothesis, experiment, verification

transition from "what is said" to "what is known" in terms of "knowing"
how far have it

7. The Breakdown of Aristotelianism via Empirical Method

Post Aral necessary, eternal, universal, changeless, to certain, true
via sense - rally in world → principles

Emp Method sense - rally in world - hypothesis
 depends intelligibility, subject to revision, comprehensive of part, developing, probable, approx towards truth

8. The Breakdown of Aristotelianism via Higher Criticism

literal meaning a rationalization - 9B Vico poetics of poetry
 complete explanation of all human phenomena of historiography



existentialism + realism

9. Neither empirical method nor the higher criticism works together as adequate

d Empirical method - depends to great extent by exclusion - eg. are we if they can be resolved by appeal to reasonable data

Metaphorically the waste basket for other eg.

hence Eth cannot adopt its own results

| fact obscured by naive mechanical determinism (or categories)
| mask elim. by relativity + Q.T.

| In the sciences of western civilization just a deconstruction of a particular anthropological process
| or are they the same sort of thing as western dress, (word, construction of language, mechanism or Africa music (or rain)

p Higher criticism - naive historicism - ^{history} the cinema of what happened
| just what history is not - historiography
naive historicism - | thinking as Paul, Kate, Douglas
| | nature of representation
| just as obscure to us as Paul that
| how can we interpret them better than Paul Kate

basic questions on knowing objectively, reality
an epistemological but never in more complicated form - | Hermeneutics
| | history

no answers - | non-objective thinking of the authentic subject
| relativism of objects [de-mythologize + nothing left]
| | everything goes into great oblivion

10. the limitations of Emp Method, Taylor Crit, can be overcome

by repeating Aristotle - ~~the~~

i.e. Post Anal reductionism = a vera philosophia

whether valid or not, it is not relevant

a method can be corrected & completed only by speaking of operational operations

its validity is challenged and to meet the challenge one has to move

from conceptual to preconceptual operations, from logic to method

if there is a philosophical instance of Post Anal, what does it get its principles

of from sense, then why are its principles certain etc

where those of empirical sc are not / necessary to consider operation

of from some other source, then what is it / necessary to consider operation

the challenge is not merely intrinsic
