1 Medieval theology : primarily internal elaboration of doctrina sacra systemic synthetic
 | Albertus Magnus
 | Aquinas

parallel to development of Canon law knowles / course systematic | Roma law, Justinian
Antistote Topics, Metaphysics, Post Anal.

2 Per se subject - static account of writers → scriptural : Exegeta 1363-1429 Layer 423
antico-syncretical, spiritual dimension

wisdom + prudence - organon of mind (universals) ontology, moral theology Layer 424

3 Relation of basic dogma + scientific doctrines to sciences - positive theology 426
