Delete one sentence, last 3 lines of p. 66, first 2 of p. 67:

Finally, there is a clear difference between mathematical and scientific probability. For the mathematical probability of a run of n successive 'heads' is always $1/2^n$. But concretely there cannot be a run of n 'heads' in m tosses, unless m at least equals n ; and the concrete probability of the concretely impossible is zero.
